

You may follow the below mentioned guidelines to complete your work. 1. Begin your letter with a declarative sentence to introduce the topic of your holiday plans. For example: "I'm writing to tell you about my exciting plans for the upcoming holiday break." 2. Use interrogative sentences to ask questions about your friend's holiday plans or to seek their opinion on certain activities. For instance: "Have you made any plans for the holidays? What do you think about going skiing together?" 3. Incorporate imperative sentences to give suggestions or invite your friend to join you for some fun activities. For example: "Let's go ice skating at the rink downtown! Bring your skates and meet me there." 4. Include exclamatory sentences to express excitement or enthusiasm about specific holiday events or experiences. For instance: "I can't wait to build a snowman with you – it's going to be so much fun!" 5. Conclude your letter with a mix of sentence types, summarizing your plans and expressing anticipation for spending time together during the holidays.
