Key Features of the Vasishtha Foundation Course (VFC)

- **Eligibility:**
Students currently studying in **Grades V to VIII**.
- **Focus Areas:**
 - Strengthening conceptual understanding in **Mathematics and Science**
 - Enhancing **critical thinking and problem-solving skills**
 - Developing **strategic practice techniques and time management skills**
- **Dedicated Arrangements :**

Common Entrance Examination – VFC 2026–27

To enroll in the Vasishtha Foundation Course, students must appear for a **Common Entrance Examination**.

- **Date: 27 February 2026 (Friday)**
- **Syllabus:**
Mathematics and Science of the student's **current class** (details given below).
- **Exam Pattern:**
 - **Total Marks:** 100 (Mathematics: 50 Marks + Science: 50 Marks)
 - **Duration:** 2 Hours
- **Selection Process:**
Selection will be based on **merit in the Entrance Examination** and the **academic performance in Term II / Annual Exam in Mathematics and Science**.

- **Important Notes:**

- Selection in a VFC class for one academic year **does not guarantee automatic promotion** to VFC in the next class.
- For example, students studying in **Class IX (VFC)** must qualify the **VFC Eligibility Test** to continue in **Class X (VFC)** in the following session.
- Students who intend to pursue **JEE/NEET preparation in Senior Secondary classes** are encouraged to opt for this programme.
