Let this Diwali light up our homes and enlighten young minds through learning, compassion, and responsibility.

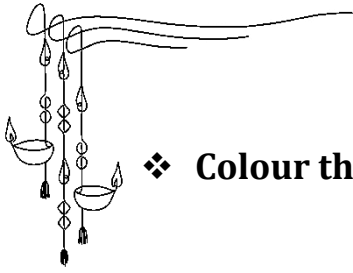
