Section	Details
Paper Size	A4
Tools Allowed	Pencil, ruler, compass, colors
Shapes to Use	At least 5 different 2D shapes (e.g., circle, triangle, square, rectangle etc.)
Symmetry Requirement	Include at least 1 line of symmetry (vertical, horizontal, or diagonal)
Coloring	Use bright colors to make your Rangoli festive and beautiful
