1.	English	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Compose a short poem (8–10 lines) or a catchy quote (20-30 words) on the topic, "Words are like Lamps".</li> <li>Highlight how words have the power to guide, inspire, or brighten someone's life through your writing.</li> </ul>
2.	Maths	<p>Imagine you are planning for a Diwali celebration. Your family has a total budget of ₹30,000. Create a detailed budget using percentages for the following categories:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Decorations: Candles, lights, rangoli colors, etc. (e.g., 15% of the budget)</li> <li>Sweets and snacks: (e.g., 25% of the budget)</li> <li>Gifts: (e.g., 30% of the budget)</li> <li>New clothes: (e.g., 20% of the budget)</li> <li>Miscellaneous: (e.g., 10% of the budget)</li> </ul> <p>Discusses with your parents and present your budget in a tabular format.</p>

Science	<p><b>Circuit Greeting Card – Communication through Light</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Create an electronic Diwali greeting card that lights up by using a simple electric circuit (LED + battery). The card should light up when opened, symbolizing how light is used as a form of communication and celebration.</li> </ul> <p><b>Instructions:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Design and decorate your card with the theme of Diwali (diyas, lanterns, fireworks, rangoli, etc.).</li> <li>2. Fix a simple circuit inside the card so that the LED glows when the card is opened.</li> <li>3. Ensure neat wiring and secure battery placement.</li> <li>4. Add short message inside your card focusing on Environmental and Social aspects of celebrating Diwali.</li> </ol>
