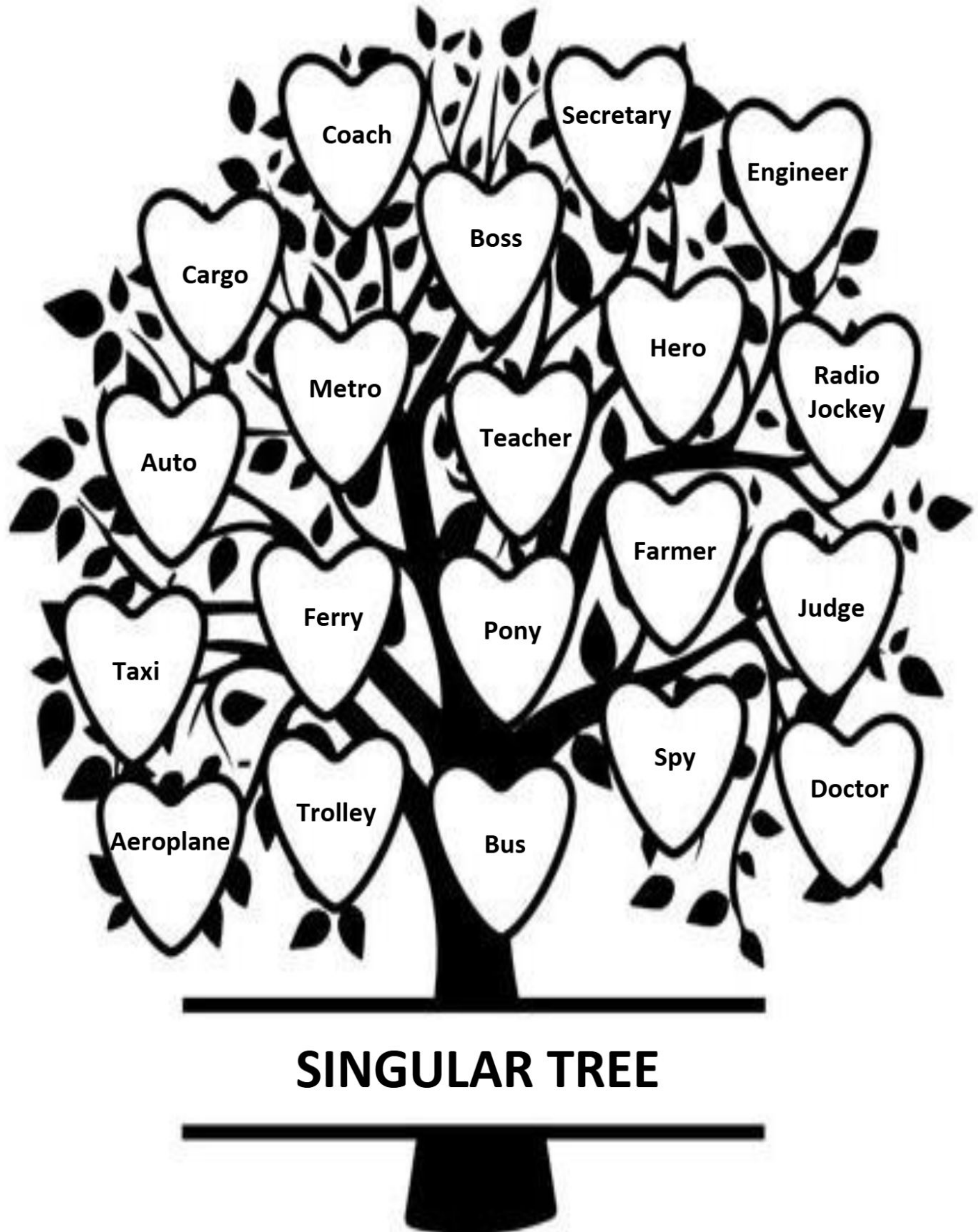

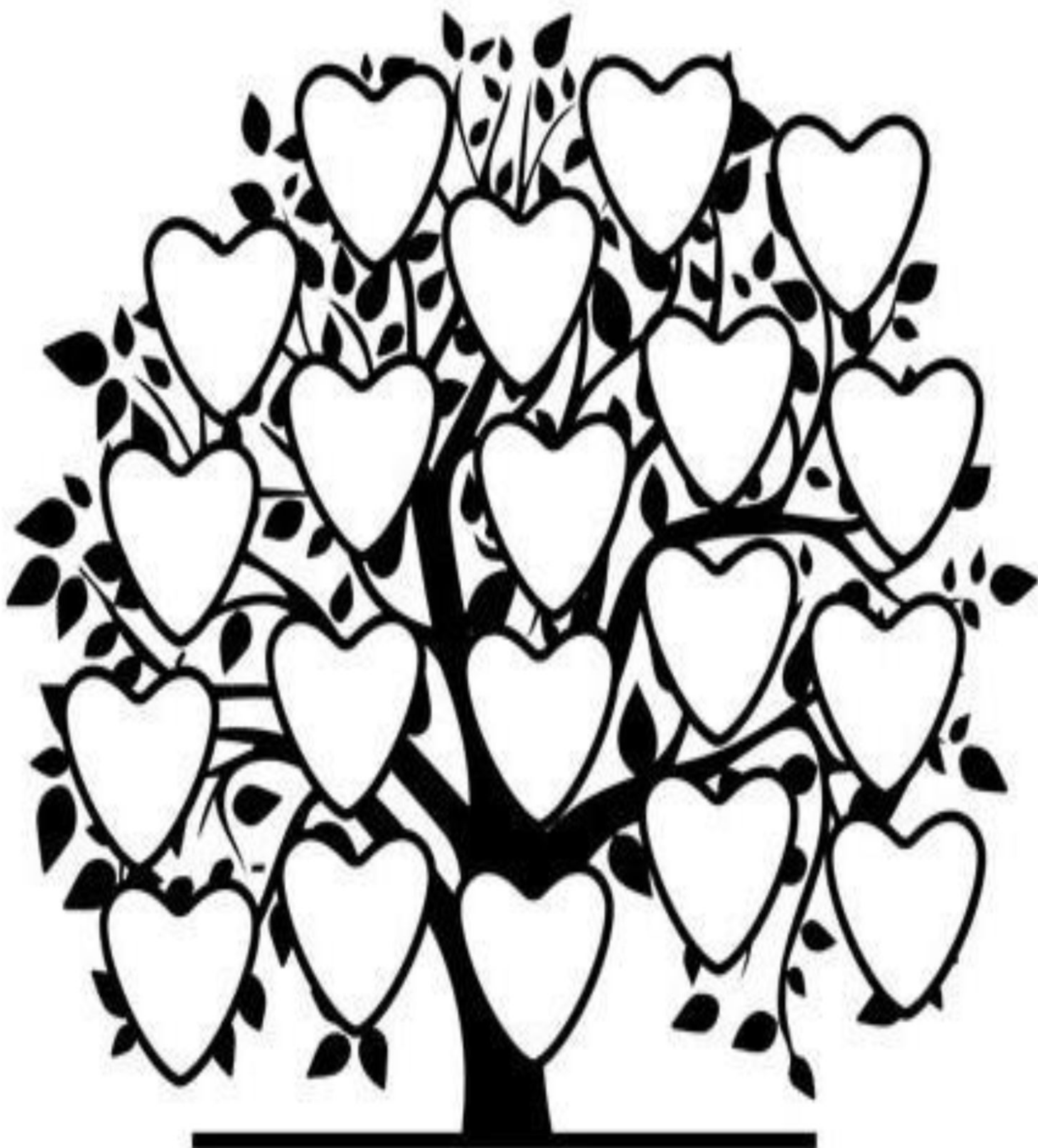

Riya is making a flower pot for her school project. She uses different types of soil and water. Help her complete the activity by solving the questions below:



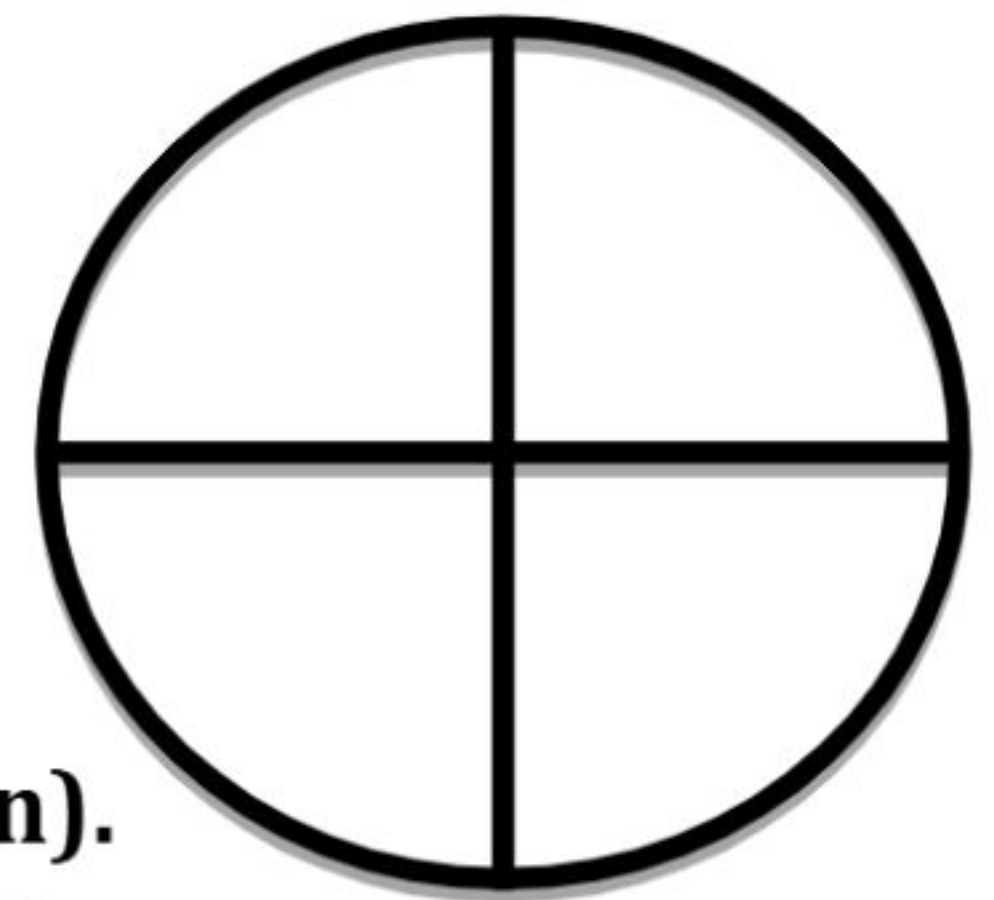
1) She filled the pot with:
