Subject: Regarding Generation of Pending APAAR ID

Dear Parents,
Greetings!

As per the Government of India's 'One Student, One ID' initiative, all students of Classes I to XII are required to have an APAAR (Automated Permanent Academic Account Registry) ID for maintaining their permanent academic record linked with the Academic Bank of Credits.

Further to the circular shared in the previous academic session, the Education Department of Gujarat has now issued fresh instructions for the compulsory generation of APAAR ID for all students.

Students without an APAAR ID may face difficulties during Board registration and while applying for competitive exams such as NEET and JEE.

A major reason for the pending APAAR ID is a mismatch between school records and Aadhaar details. Parents are therefore requested to ensure that the details of the child, mother, and father in school records exactly match their Aadhaar Cards. In case of any discrepancy, kindly update the Aadhaar details at the earliest.
