



Types of Maps

Political maps

- * states, national boundaries and different places

Physical maps

- * physical features like rivers, mountains, lakes etc

Thematic maps

- * specific information like rainfall, vegetation etc

D. Answer these questions -

Q.1) What are cardinal directions? Name the sub-directions.

Ans- The cardinal directions are the four main compass directions: north, south, east and west commonly denoted by their initials N, S, E, and W respectively.

North-East (NE), North-West (NW), South-East (SE) and South-West (SW) are the four sub-directions.

Q.2) Differentiate between a sketch and a plan.

sketch

a) A sketch is a rough drawing of a place.

b) It is not drawn to the scale.

c) It represents the main features of an area with the help of landmarks.

plan

a) A plan is a drawing that shows horizontal section of an area.

b) It is drawn to the scale.

c) It represents a small area on a large scale in detail.

Q.3) Name the colours used in a map. What do they represent?

Ans- Blue colour is used to represent water bodies; brown is for the mountains; yellow is for the plateaus and green is for the plains.

Q.4) How are symbols useful?

Ans- Symbols give more information in a limited space, making it easier to read and understand maps and locate a place on the map.

Q.5) Name the different types of maps.

Ans- The different types of maps are-

(a) Political map - It shows states, national boundaries and different places.

(b) Physical map - It shows the physical features like rivers, lakes etc.

(c) Thematic map - It displays specific information like rainfall, vegetation etc.


1)  - Main road
