Subject-Verb Agreement

You know that in a sentence, the verbs (main and auxiliary) have to match the subject in number (singular or plural). This is called subject-verb agreement.

- singular The child is playing in the park.
- plural The children are playing in the park.

#### Collective nouns

Collective nouns are treated as a single unit and thus, take a singular verb.

- A herd of cows grazes in this field.
- Our team is the winner of the quiz.

When two singular nouns or pronouns are joined with and in a sentence, they

- Anthony and Sarah is friends.
- X Anthony and Sarah are friends.

When two singular nouns joined with and in a sentence refer to the same person, they take singular verbs.

 The director and actor, Jyoti Singh, is the new member of the film review committee.
