Ch – 4 Singular and plural Nouns

- Nouns can be singular or Plural.
- A singular noun means names of one person, animal, place or thing.
- A Plural noun means names of more than one person, animal, place or thing.
- We add **-s** or **-es** to make plurals of most singular nouns.
- Generally, we add **-es** to nouns ending with **o**, **x**, **s**, **ss**, **ch**, and **sh** to make Plurals.
