REMEMBER

- In singular nouns, we use the apostrophe before the 's'—sister's school.
- In plural nouns, we usually use the apostrophe after the 's'—boys' teams.
- In singular nouns ending with 's', we usually use the apostrophe + the 's' after the noun—hippopotamus's teeth, Mr Das's book.
