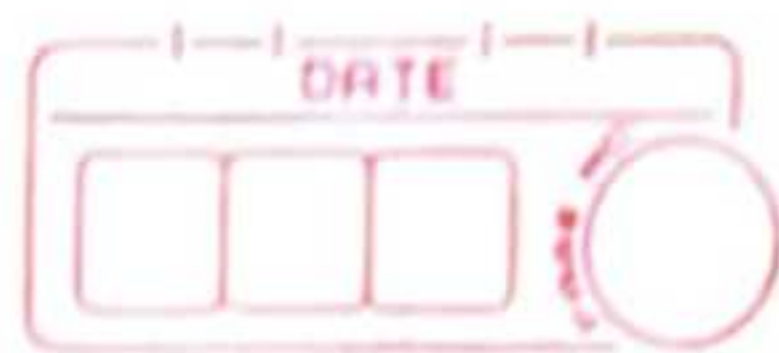

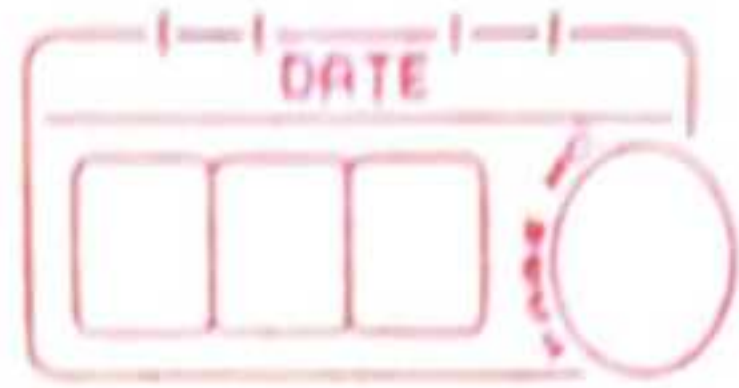
* Meanings

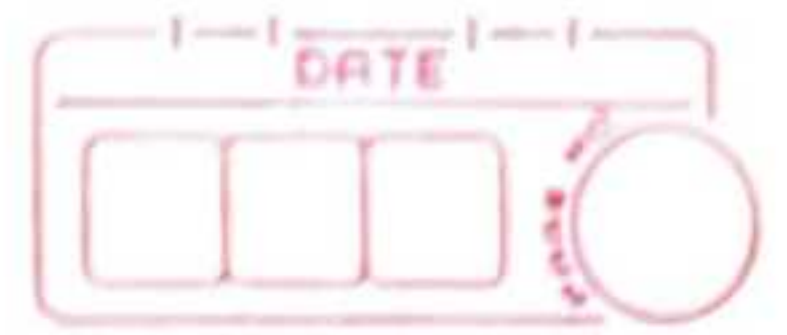
