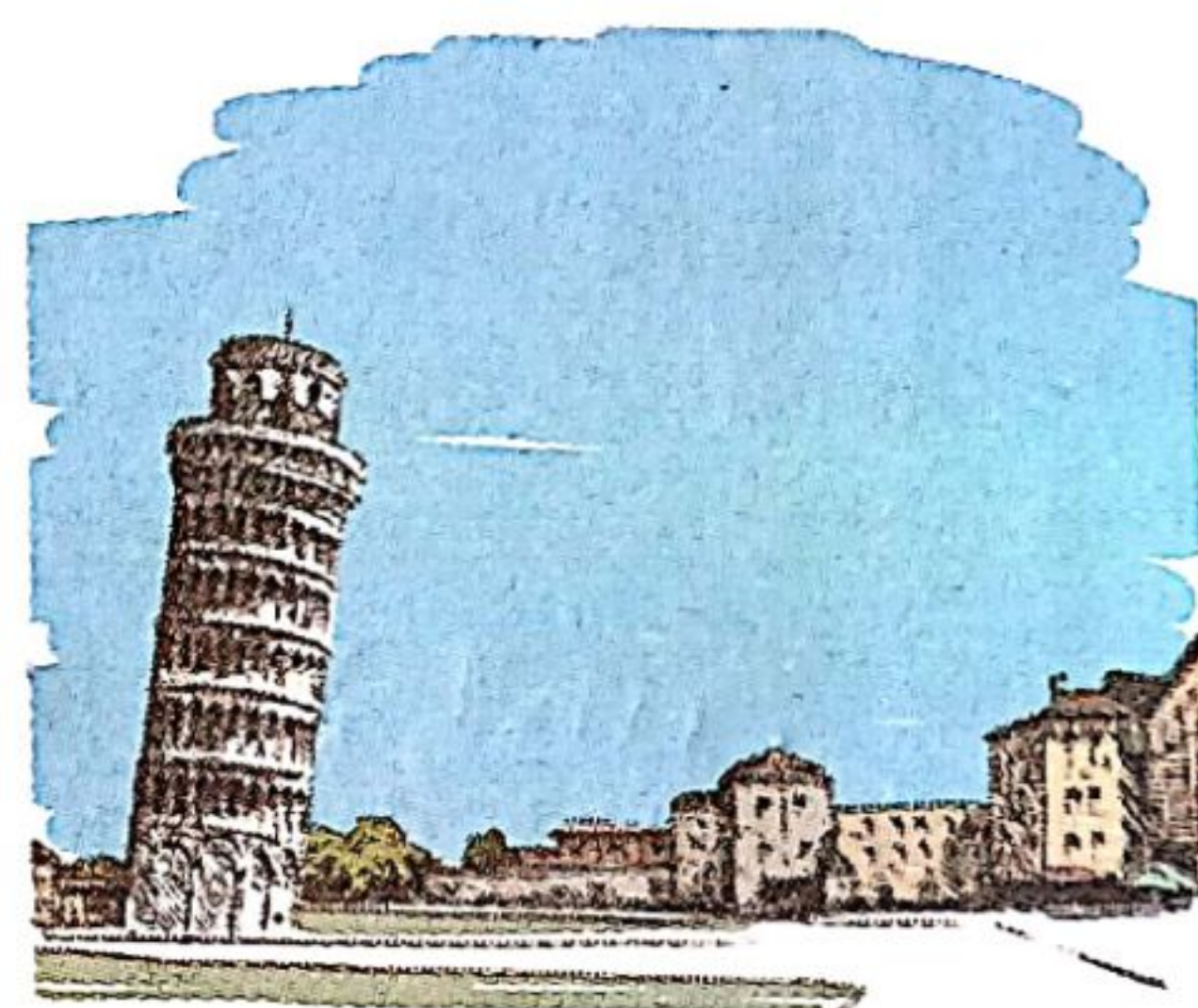

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## LEARN

Notice that in sentences 2, 4, and 5, the word **will** comes before the verbs **travel**, **go** and **start** and together they tell us that the actions are going to happen after the time that we are talking about them.

These sentences are in the **simple future tense**. The simple future tense tells us about an action that will take place later.

The verb **will** is used with the verbs of the simple future tense.

Let us look at some more examples.

- We will not reach the theatre in time if we don't leave now.
- Disha said she will return my notebook tomorrow.
- Adab will act in a play next week.
- They will do well in the test this time.
- Will Thomas take us to the zoo tomorrow?
- Will you bake me a cake?
