* Proper Nouns

A proper noun is the specific name of a particular person, place, animal, or thing. It always begins with a capital letter, no matter where it appears in a sentence.

Examples of proper nouns:

- **Person:** Vijay, Hema, Roni, Siya, Ravi, Panth
- **Place:** Shree Vidyalaya, Sayaji Garden, Kamala Nehru Zoo, City Hospital
- **Animals (specific names):** (a dog) Tommy, (a cat) Mittu, Simba (a lion) Sheru, Shere Khan (a tiger) Raja, Nemo (a fish) Goldy
- **Things (specific titles or names):** The Eiffel Tower, Mona Lisa, Samsung, Galaxy, Coca-Cola, Harry Potter (book), Black Forest Cake
