## Ch-2 Common Nouns and Gender

### \* Common Nouns

- A **common noun** is a general name for a person, place, animal, or thing. It **does not** refer to a specific name or title and is **not capitalized** unless it starts a sentence.

#### Examples of common nouns:

- **Person:** girl, boy, teacher, doctor, father
- **Place:** school, park, zoo, hospital, classroom
- **Animals:** dog, cat, lion, tiger, sparrow, fish
- **Things:** bench, flower, tree, bag, spoon, cake

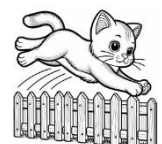
