Ans. A train that carries passengers is called a passenger train. A train that carries goods is called a goods train.


iv. **How do bicycle and cycle rickshaws move?**

Ans. A Bicycle and cycle rickshaw are pulled by the muscular energy of the man driving it.


v. **Why are camels used as means of transport in the desert area?**

Ans. Camels have padded hooves which help them to move easily in the desert so they are used in the desert for travelling.


