

 4. The names, boundaries and positions of cities shown on the map agree with the Revised Census map issued by the Survey of India, Series D (Administrative) (Map No. 148) (1983 & 1987) (Scale 1:10,00,000).
 5. The administrative boundaries of Chandigarh, Jammu and Kashmir and Puducherry are shown.
