1. What is a public place?

Ans-A public place is an area or building that anyone in the community can use. Public places belong to everyone. These places help a community function well and meet people's needs.

1. What is history?

Ans- The study of the past is called history.

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2. Why do we study history?

Ans-History helps us understand the world before us. It tells us how people lived long ago and how their ideas, inventions and actions shaped the world we live in today.

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3. Name two inventions that changed the lives of early humans.

Ans-The two inventions that changed early human life are wheel and fire.

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4. Who are historians? What do they do?

Ans-Historians are people who read and study written records to understand what life was like in the past. They use clues left behind by people long ago, called sources of history, to learn how people lived, what they believed and what they created.

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5. What are the two main types of sources of history?

Ans-The two main types of sources of history are:

(i) Archaeological Sources – These are old objects, structures and remains from the past. They tell us about the lives of people for times when written records are not available.

(ii) Literary Sources – These are written records that tell us about the past. They were written on palm leaves, tree bark and later on paper.

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6. Name two archaeological sources and two literary sources.

Ans-The two archaeological sources are monuments and artefacts, and the literary sources are religious texts and manuscripts.

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7. What do artefacts tell us about the past?

Ans-Artefacts tell us about the past by helping us understand daily life, craft skills and traditions of people long ago.

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8. How are archaeological and literary sources like puzzle pieces?

Ans-Archaeological and literary sources are like puzzle pieces because each gives us different clues about the past. When we put them together, they give us a complete picture of how people lived, worked and thought long ago.

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
