Answer the following questions..

Q.1. How is air taken to all parts of the body of an insect?

Ans.1. Insects have holes on their bodies called spiracles which help them to breathe.

Q.2. How is a bird's body suitable for flying?

A.2. Birds have wings instead of arms, which help them to fly.

Q.3. How do whales and dolphins breathe?

A.3. Whales and dolphins have lungs to breathe. They come to the surface of water to inhale fresh air and exhale the stale air in the water through nostrils called blowholes.

Q.4. Why do fish lay thousands of eggs at a time?

A.4. They lay thousands of eggs because some eggs

and baby fishes that hatch out of them are eaten by other fishes.

Q.5. How do mammals look after their young ones?

A.5. They guard their babies, keep them clean, feed them and look after them until they are old enough to look after themselves.
