Ruhaan loves his **blue** car.

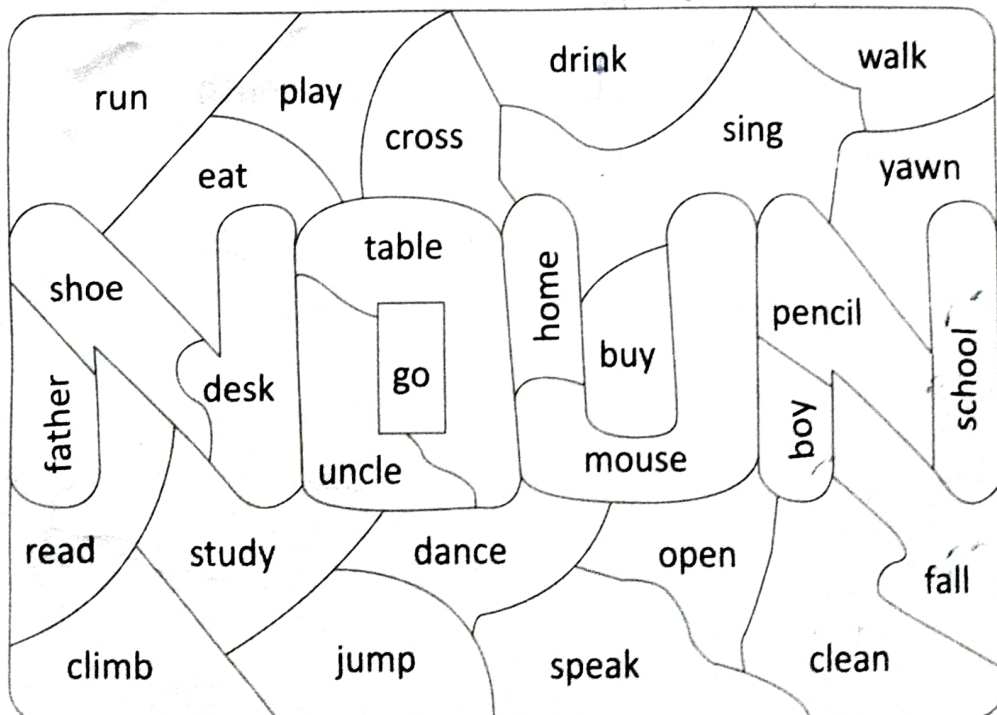
