Starter

We wear clothes to cover our body. They protect us from heat, cold, rain, dust and insect bites. We wear different clothes on different occasions and in different seasons.

There are three major seasons: **Winter**, **Summer** and **Rainy** season.

Winter Season

It is cold during winter. So, we wear woollen clothes.

Woollen clothes keep us warm.



Summer Season

It is hot during summer. So, we wear light coloured cotton clothes.

Cotton clothes keep us cool.



Rainy Season

We do not want to get wet when it rains. So, we wear a raincoat over our clothes. We may also use an umbrella. We can wear gumboots to keep our feet dry.



Teacher's note:

Discuss about the different types of clothes worn in different seasons. Make children understand the importance of being well dressed. Arrange a costume parade in the class.

Special Clothes

In schools and some offices, people wear special set of clothes that look exactly the same. This is called a **uniform**. The uniform of each place is different and special.

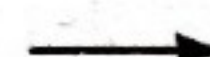

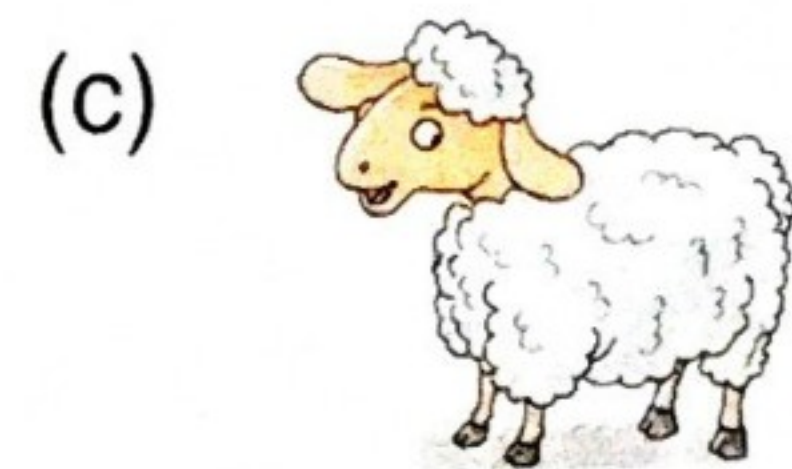

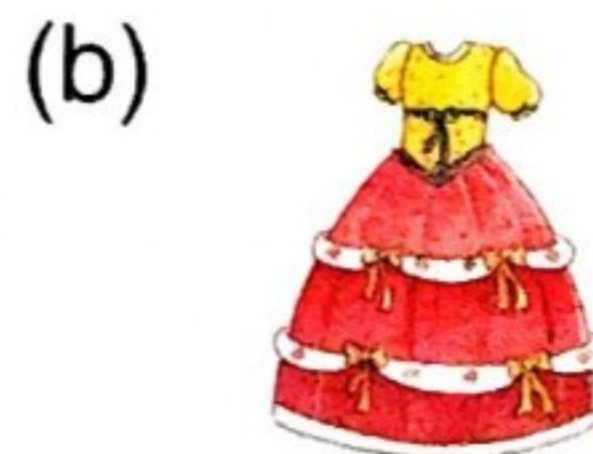
