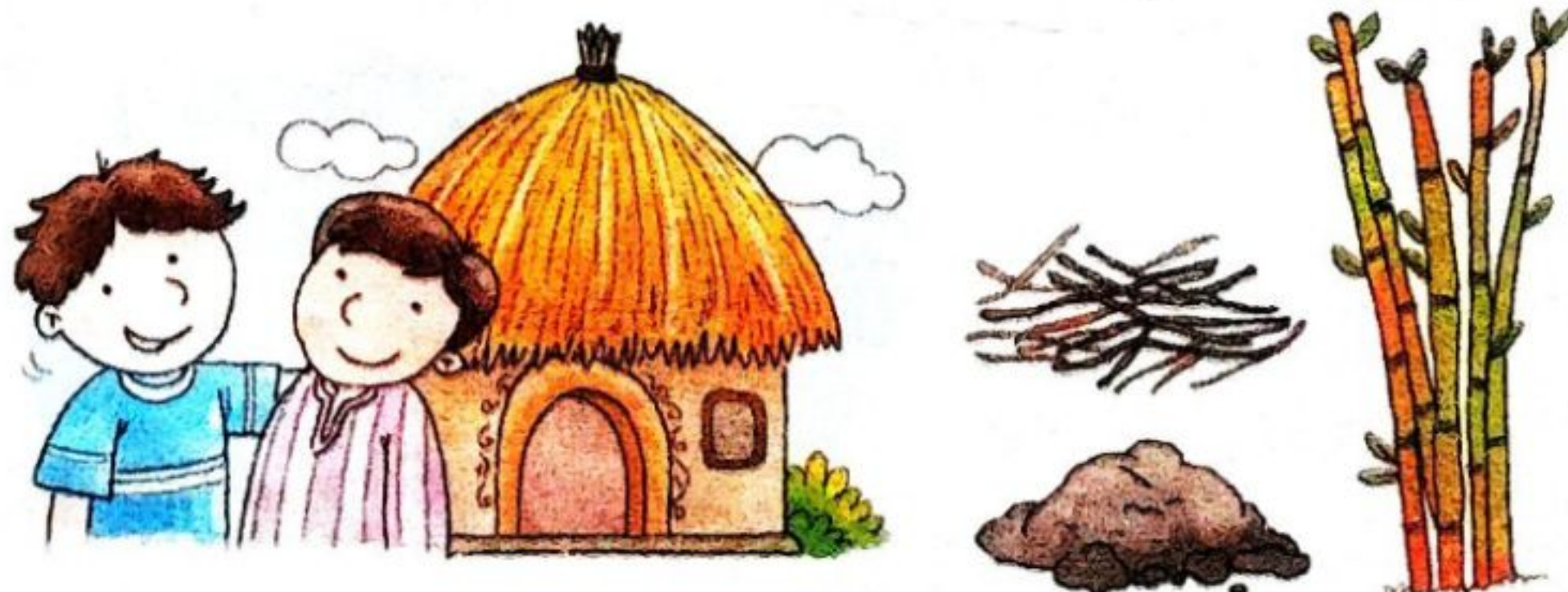
Everyone needs a place to live in. The house where we live with our family is called our home. It protects us from heat, cold and rain. It also protects us from animals and thieves.

Different Kinds of Houses

There are mainly two types of houses: **Kutcha** houses and **Pucca** houses.

Kutcha houses are made up of mud, straw, bamboo and leaves. They are not very strong.

This is my friend Tushar. He has a *kutcha* house in a nearby village. It is called a **hut**.



A house made of bricks, cement, steel and wood is called a **pucca** house. *Pucca* houses are strong houses, mostly found in cities and towns.

This is Rohan's house.
It is called a flat.
A flat is a *pucca* house.

Talk about the importance of a house. Show them pictures of different types of houses. Talk about the usefulness of various rooms in the house. Encourage children to keep their house clean.

A bungalow is a big house.



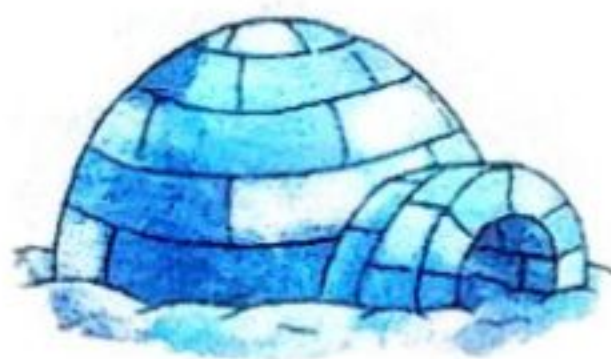
