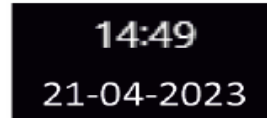

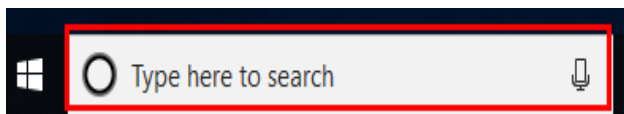

5. Define CLI:

Ans. Using a Command Line Interface (CLI), the user interacts with the operating system by typing commands with the keyboard to perform specific tasks.

6. Define GUI:

Ans. Using a Graphical User Interface (GUI), the user interacts with the operating system by using keyboard and mouse to access icons, menus, etc.

7. Define Start Icon:

Ans. It is an icon located at the bottom left corner of the desktop screen to open the Start menu.
