1. Why are houses important to us?

Ans: Houses protect us from heat, cold, rain, animals and thieves. They give us shelter and safety.

2. What kind of clothes do we wear in winter and why?

3. What are stilts?

Ans: Stilt are strong tall poles that hold the house up and above the ground.

Ans: Two safety rules we should follow on the road are:
