Guidelines for Writing a Good Story

- * Start with a clear beginning
- * Have a simple middle
- * End the story properly
- * Use simple and clear language
- * Make it interesting
- * Keep the story in order
- * Use good vocabulary
- * Add a moral (lesson)

Q1. Read the given outline and create a story. Also mention Title and Moral of the story:

i. **Outlines:** A lion scares all animals in the forest - Animals decide to send one animal daily - A clever rabbit is chosen - Rabbit reaches late and tells about another lion - Takes lion to a well - Lion jumps in, thinking it's his enemy - Lion dies - Animals are safe

The Clever Rabbit

Once upon a time, a hungry lion lived in a forest. Every day, he hunted animals, and soon the animals became scared. They made a plan to send one animal daily to the lion.
