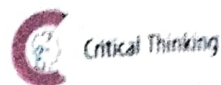

home in the afternoon. I *eat* my lunch.

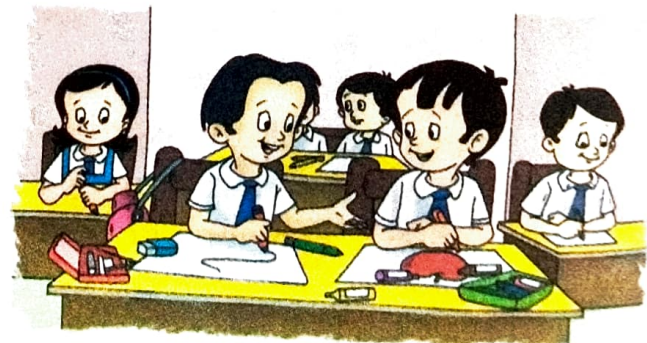
