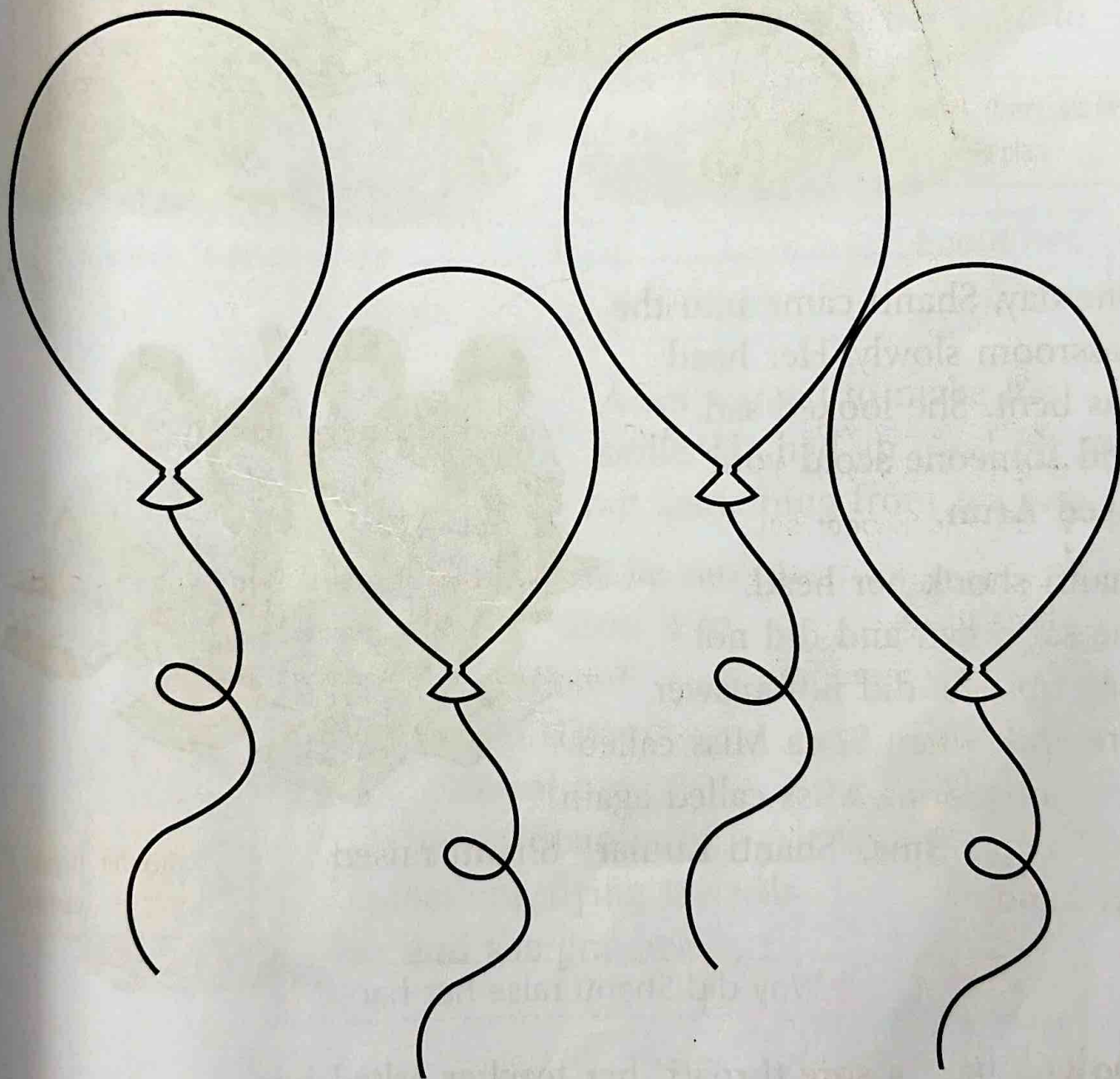


7. No Smiles Today

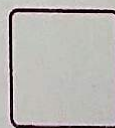

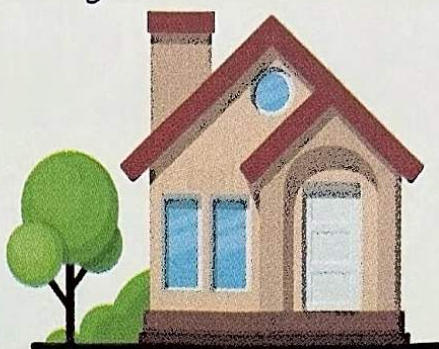
